Focus Areas

1. EDUCATION

PROMOTE AND ACHIEVE HIGH EDUCATIONAL STANDARDS

- Review, discuss, and analyze data from formative and summative assessments; support the use of data for curriculum planning, professional development and reaching student achievement targets.
- Assist educators and students in the implementation of the NH DOE K-8 Competencies and the transition to Common Core State Standards, performance and Smarter Balanced assessments.
- Continue to develop and implement a consistent, positive behavior model for all students with the involvement of all educators.
- Continue to develop, refine, and implement the Response to Intervention Program K-8 with an emphasis on the use of data to drive instructional decisions while providing the necessary staffing, materials, and funding resources.

2. FACILITIES

ADDRESS SPACE NEEDS ISSUES IN THE ALLENSTOWN SCHOOLS

- Conduct a quarterly review of current and future space/building needs.
- Develop an asset management program and detailed replacement schedule to include 1, 3, and 5 year targets which explain the impact on teaching and learning for each decision.
- Develop a strategic capital improvement plan that addresses the current and future needs of the district, with outcomes after 1, 3, 5, 10 years and beyond.
- Continue to pursue a more efficient, environmentally friendly school environment.

- Continue to strengthen parent and community partnerships by supporting at least 6 parent informational meetings and/or celebratory events during the school year.

- Continue to review and modify the schools' operating principles to ensure a welcoming, respectful, and inclusive culture.
